**1. Description of the Industry in which the Company Operates**

Grenreal Property Corporation Limited (the "Company") has been specifically set up to enable local and regional private, professional and institutional investors to benefit from the positive effects on real estate market of the successful development of the cruise tourism in Grenada in particular and the development of Grenada as a tourist destination in general.

The Company is the owner of two completed properties located on the reclaimed land of the St. George's New Cruise Port, the "Esplanade Mall" and the "Dr. Jan Bosch Building".

The two properties are rented to third parties and have very low vacancies. The combined value of the two buildings is approximately ECS\$66 million. The Company has an equity value of over ECS\$30 million and is presently owned by private as well as public entities. The Company wishes to extend its shareholder base and therefore listed its shares at the Eastern Caribbean Securities Exchange in St. Kitts and Nevis in July 2008.






